



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**BOROUGH OF DOUGLAS (MURRAYS ROAD)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2004**

Coming into Operation: 11th March 2004

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985¹ and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 to the Act as required by Section 3 (1) and after having been satisfied that Section 1(8) of the Act does not apply, the following Order is hereby made :-

1. Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the Borough of Douglas (Murrays Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 2004 and shall come into operation at 6.00 a.m. on Thursday 11th March 2004.

(2) In this Order –

“the Act” means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985; and

“the Department” means the Department of Transport.

2. Closure of road to vehicular traffic

Subject to Article 3, no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause any vehicle to proceed on Murrays Road, Douglas, as indicated in the schedule.

3. Exemptions

Article 2 does not apply to a vehicle engaged in the service of a local authority or the Department of Transport in pursuance of

(1) a vehicle engaged in any of the following operations:

- (a) works in land or premises adjacent to the road specified in Article 2;
 - (b) works in the road specified in Article 2 authorised by statutory provisions;

(c) in the service of a local authority or the Department of Transport in pursuance of any statutory functions in the road or in adjacent land or premises if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes on any other road; or

(2) a vehicle being used in the course of duty for the police, fire brigade, ambulance or coastguard service; or

(3) a vehicle for which the driver holds a permit issued by the Department of Transport for its use in the road, at a time or for a purpose specified in the permit; or

4. Duration

The Order shall continue in force until 6.00 p.m. on Friday 16th April 2004 or until the pipe installation work is completed, whichever is the earlier.

Schedule

- (i) Palatine Road to Laureston Avenue
- (ii) Laureston Avenue to Waverley Road
- (iii) Waverley Road to Bathurst Street
- (iv) Bathurst Street to Princes Avenue
- (v) Princes Avenue to Glen Falcon Road

No more than 1 section closed at any 1 time, as indicated by signs.

EXPLANATORY NOTE *(This note is not a part of the Order)*

The effect of this Order is to prohibit vehicular traffic from proceeding along that section of Murrays Road, in the Borough of Douglas, whilst pipe installation work takes place.

An alternative route will be via York Road or via Derby Road.
