**CMA RAMSEY MOTORCYCLE SHOW
(RAMSEY MARKET PLACE) ORDER 2004**

Coming into Operation

3rd May 2004

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 38 of the Highways Act 1986¹, and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Introductory

1. Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the CMA Ramsey Motorcycle Show (Ramsey Market Place) Order 2004 and shall come into operation on the 3rd May 2004.

2. Interpretation

(1) In this Order :-

“Show” means the CMA Ramsey Motorcycle Show;

“the Show day” means Monday 3rd May 2004;

“Show period” means from the hour of 8.00 a.m. until the Show is officially notified as completed in accordance with Article 7 or until not later than the hour of 6.00 p.m. whichever may be the earlier;

“the Department” means the Department of Transport;

“closure period” means from the hour of 8.00 a.m. until the Show is officially notified as completed in accordance with Article 7 or until not later than the hour of 6.00 p.m. whichever may be the earlier;

“scheduled road” means the road set out and described in the Schedule;

“the promoter” means the Christian Motorcyclists Association;

“the senior police officer” means a member of the Isle of Man Constabulary of the rank of sergeant or above who is authorised by the Chief Constable to act as senior police officer under this Order.

Authorisation to use roads for the Show

3. Authorisation of use of Show site for the Show

- (1) The promoter is authorised to use the Show site for the Show on the day and time specified in Article 2(1).
- (2) The promoter may for any reason cancel the Show, or any section of the Show.
- (3) Where the promoter cancels the Show or any section of the Show under paragraph (2) and notifies the senior police officer of such cancellation the relevant authorisation under paragraph (1) of this paragraph shall cease to have effect so far as it relates to the Show or section of the Show.

Regulation of traffic etc.

4. Suspension of right of way etc.

Subject to Article 7, during any closure period in relation to any part of the Show site -
no traffic may pass on to or over it.

5. Exemptions from Article 4

Article 4 does not apply to the following vehicles -

- (a) vehicles approved by the promoters or the senior police officer;
- (b) motor-cycles engaged in the Show.

Administration

6. Publicity for cancellation etc.

Where the senior police officer is notified of the cancellation of the Show or a section of the Show under Article 3(3), he shall take such measures as he considers appropriate to inform the public of the effect of it.

7. Notification of end of closure

- (1) At the end of the Show period on the Show day for which an authorisation under Article 3 is in force -
 - (a) the promoters, or
 - (b) the senior police officer after consulting the promoters,

shall make such provisions as seem most expedient for giving official notification to the public of the conclusion of the Show and the opening of the Show site to traffic.

8. Erection of barriers and signs

- (1) The promoter shall ensure that barriers, diversion signs and closure signs are erected and

maintained on all roads leading on to the Show site immediately before, or as soon as possible after, the beginning of every closure period on the Show day, and in any event before the relevant part of the Show site is used.

(2) The barriers referred to in paragraph (1) shall consist of -

(a) tubular steel structures supplied by the Department with suitable signs attached, in any case where the Department so directs; or

(b) a rope across the road with a suitable red flag attached, in any other case.

(3) The closure signs referred to in paragraphs (1) and (2)(a) shall be of the size, colour and type shown in diagram 616 in Schedule 2 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1994².

9. Insurance

The promoter shall secure the following insurance and indemnities -

(1) against injury and damage to persons or property arising out of the conduct of the Show;

(2) any claims or liability on the Department arising from the conduct of the Show.

10. Notice of the making of the Order

Public notice of this Order shall be given in one Isle of Man Newspaper.

SCHEDULE

1. The designated vehicle parking area in Market Place, Ramsey, abutting the carriageway as indicated by barriers erected thereon.

2. The western carriageway on Market Place from its junction with King Street to its junction with West Quay (fronting "Nightlife").

3. Market Hill from its junction with Market Place to its junction with Parliament Street/Bourne Place.
