



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**SWING BRIDGE AND ASSOCIATED FIXED BRIDGE (RAMSEY)
(TEMPORARY REVERSAL OF ONE WAY TRAFFIC) (NO 2) ORDER 2004**

Coming into Operation: 8th June 2004

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985¹ and all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 to the Act as required by Section 3(1) the following Order is hereby made :-

1. Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the Swing Bridge and Associated Fixed Bridge (Ramsey) (Temporary Reversal of One Way Traffic) (No 2) Order 2004 and shall come into operation at 2.00 p.m. on 8th June 2004.

2. Temporary reversal of one way traffic

The provisions of paragraph 16 in Schedule 1 of the Various Roads (Ramsey) (One-Way Traffic) (Consolidation) Order 1999² shall be temporarily reversed so as to require vehicular traffic to travel in a southerly direction only along the Ramsey Swing Bridge and associated fixed bridge from its junction with the Old River Road to its junction with West Quay.

3. Duration

This Order shall continue in force until 6.00 p.m. on 8th June 2004. In the event of adverse weather conditions or any other circumstances which may obtain on the 8th June 2004 the Ramsey Sprint may be postponed to 10th June 2004 and in such event this Order shall have effect where the context so admits as if that day were substituted for 8th June 2004.

This Order effects the temporary reversal of the traffic flow from northerly to southerly over the Ramsey Swing Bridge and associated fixed bridge to facilitate traffic movement during and immediately following the Ramsey Sprint practices and races.
