**LEGAL AID ACT 1986
DUTY ADVOCATE (POLICE CUSTODY)(AMENDMENT) SCHEME 2004**

*Coming into operation - 1 June 2004
Laid before Tynwald - 18 May 2004*

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Legal Aid Committee by section 21(1A) of the Legal Aid Act 1986^(a), of all other enabling powers, and with the concurrence of the Treasury, the following Scheme is hereby made :-

Citation and commencement

1. This Scheme may be cited as the Duty Advocate (Police Custody) (Amendment) Scheme 2004 and shall come into operation on 1 June 2004.

Amendment of S.D. No. 619/98

2. In clause 13 of the Duty Advocate (Police Custody) Scheme 1998^(b) -

(a) in paragraph (1) -

- (i) in subparagraph (a), for "£105" substitute "£125";
(ii) in subparagraph (b), for "£65" substitute "£77";

(b) for paragraph (3) insert -

"(3) A member of the panel, being a senior advocate, shall be remunerated by the Treasury at the following rates -

- (a) £290 for each period of 7 days during which he is available under clause 8(4);
(b) in addition, £94 for each hour or part of an hour during which he -

- (i) is consulted by the duty advocate under clause 8(4)(a);
(ii) attends at a police station to act as duty advocate under clause 8(4)(b),


together with his reasonable travelling expenses at a rate determined by the Treasury."
