



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**VICARAGE ROAD (BRADDAN)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2005**

Coming into Operation: 12th January 2005

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985¹ and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 to the Act as required by Section 3 (1) and after having been satisfied that Section 1(8) of the Act does not apply, the following Order is hereby made :-

1. Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the Vicarage Road (Braddan) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 2005 and shall come into operation at 6.00 a.m. on Wednesday 12th January 2005.

(2) In this Order –

“the Act” means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985; and

“the Department” means the Department of Transport.

2. Closure of road to vehicular traffic

Subject to Article 3, no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause any vehicle to proceed on that section of Vicarage Road, Braddan, between a point 50 metres east of the roundabout at Stevenson’s Way to a point 10 metres west of the roundabout at Stevenson’s Way.

3. Exemptions

Article 2 does not apply to a vehicle engaged in the service of a local authority or the Department of Transport in pursuance of

(1) a vehicle engaged in any of the following operations:

- (a) works in land or premises adjacent to the road specified in Article 2;
 - (b) works in the road specified in Article 2 authorised by statutory provisions;
- or

- (c) in the service of a local authority or the Department of Transport in pursuance of any statutory functions in the road or in adjacent land or premises if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes on any other road; or
- (2) a vehicle being used in the course of duty for the police, fire brigade, ambulance or coastguard service; or
- (3) a vehicle for which the driver holds a permit issued by the Department of Transport for its use in the road, at a time or for a purpose specified in the permit.

4. Duration

The Order shall continue in force until 6.00 p.m. on Saturday 26th February 2005 or until the road reconstruction and realignment work is completed, whichever is the earlier.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to prohibit vehicular traffic from proceeding along a section of Vicarage Road, in the Parish of Braddan, whilst road reconstruction and realignment work takes place.

An alternative route will be via Cooil Road, New Castletown Road and Peel Road.
