**POST OFFICE ACT 1993  
POST OFFICE (OVERSEAS LETTER POST) (AMENDMENT NO.1) SCHEME 2005**

**Laid before Tynwald: 19 – 21 April 2005  
Coming into Operation: 7<sup>th</sup> April 2005**

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Post Office by Sections 13 and 59(2) of the Post Office Act 1993 (a) ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Department of Industry, the following Scheme is hereby made:-

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Scheme may be cited as the Post Office (Overseas Letter Post) (Amendment No.1) Scheme 2005 and shall come into operation on 7<sup>th</sup> April 2005.

**Amendments of the principal Regulations**

2. The Isle of Man Post Office Authority (Overseas Letter Post) Regulations 1977 (b) (in this Scheme referred to as "the principal Regulations") are further amended in accordance with Schedule 1.

**Revocations**

3. The public documents mentioned in Schedule 2 are revoked to the extent specified in the third column of that Schedule.

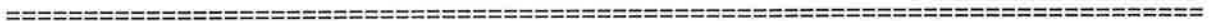

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**  
**(This Note is not part of the Scheme)**

1. This Scheme further amends the Isle of Man Post Office Authority (Overseas Letter Post) Regulations 1977 (GC No. 113/77 as amended) by revising the postage charges on surface letters, postcards, printed papers and small packets sent to destinations in Europe and worldwide.
2. The revised postage charges and fees take effect from 7<sup>th</sup> April 2005.
