



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**BOROUGH OF DOUGLAS (QUEENS TERRACE/QUEENS AVENUE)  
(TEMPORARY REVERSAL OF ONE WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 2005**

*Coming into Operation: 8<sup>th</sup> March 2005*

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985<sup>1</sup> and all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 to the Act as required by Section 3(1) the following Order is hereby made :-

**1. Citation and commencement**

This Order may be cited as the Borough of Douglas (Queens Terrace/Queens Avenue) (Temporary Reversal of One Way Traffic) Order 2005 and shall come into operation at 6.00 a.m. on Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> March 2005.

**2. Temporary reversal of one way traffic**

The provisions of the Borough of Douglas One Way Traffic Streets Order 1981 No 66 and 67 shall be temporarily reversed so as to require vehicular traffic to travel on Queens Terrace, Douglas, in a south-easterly direction only from its junction with Alexander Drive to its junction with Queens Avenue, and to require traffic to travel on Queens Avenue, Douglas, in a northerly direction only from its junction with Queens Terrace to its junction with Alexander Drive.

**3. Duration**

This Order shall continue in force until 6.00 p.m. on Friday 10<sup>th</sup> June 2005 for a trial period of three months for traffic calming purposes.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not a part of the Order)*

This Order effects the temporary reversal of the traffic flow on Queens Terrace, Douglas, from north-westerly to south-easterly and on Queens Avenue, Douglas, from southerly to northerly for a trial period of three months for traffic calming purposes.
