



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**B40 GRENABY ROAD (ARBORY)
(TEMPORARY WEIGHT RESTRICTION) (NO 2) ORDER 2005**

Coming into Operation: 11th June 2005

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985¹, and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 to the Act as required by Section 3(1) the following Order is hereby made :-

1. Citation, duration and interpretation

(1) This Order may be cited as the B40 Grenaby Road (Arbory) (Temporary Weight Restriction) (No 2) Order 2005 and shall have effect for the period commencing 11th June 2005 and ending on 12th June 2005.

(2) In this Order "the Road Race Order" means the Isle of Man Steam Packet Road Races Order 2005².

2. Temporary weight restriction

Save as provided in Article 3, no person shall cause any vehicle the gross weight of which exceeds 7.5 tonnes to proceed in that length of the B40 Grenaby Road from Ballabeg to its junction with B41 Kerrowkeil Road at Grenaby during the periods of the Isle of Man Steam Packet Road Races Motorcycle practices and races as specified in Article 3 and 4 of the Road Race Order.

3. Exemptions

Nothing in Article 2 shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any vehicle to proceed in that length of the road referred to in that Article if the vehicle is being used with the prior approval of the Department of Transport or for emergency vehicles.

The effect of this Order is to impose a temporary weight restriction of 7.5 tonnes gross on a length of the B40 Grenaby Road during the period of the Isle of Man Steam Packet Races motorcycle practices and races.
