



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**MOANEY ROAD (SANTON)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2005**

*Coming into Operation: 14<sup>th</sup> March 2005*

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985<sup>1</sup>, and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 to the Act as required by Section 3(1), and having been satisfied that Section 1(8) of the Act does not apply, the following Order is hereby made:-

**1. Citation and commencement**

This Order may be cited as the Moaney Road (Santon) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 2005 and shall come into operation from 6.00 a.m. on Monday 14<sup>th</sup> March 2005.

2) In this Order –

“the Act “ means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985; and

“the Department” means the Department of Transport

**2. Closure of road to vehicular traffic**

Subject to Article 3, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed on that section of the Moaney Road, Santon, between its junction with the A5 Douglas to Castletown Road and its junction with the Rheast Road.

**3. Exemption**

Article 2 does not apply to a vehicle requiring access to premises or land adjacent to the road specified in Article 2 or to –

(1) a vehicle engaged in any of the following operations –

(a) works in land or premises adjacent to the road specified in Article 2;

- (b) works in the road specified in Article 2 authorised by statutory provisions;  
or
  - (c) in the service of the Department or a local authority in pursuance of any statutory functions in the road or in adjacent land or premises if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes on any other road; or
- (1) a vehicle being used in the course of duty for the police, fire brigade, ambulance or other emergency service; or
  - (2) a vehicle for which the driver holds a permit issued by the Department for its use in the road, at a time or for a purpose specified in the permit; or
  - (3) such vehicular traffic as may be authorised by the Department.

#### 4. Duration

The Order shall continue in force from 6.00 a.m. on Monday 14<sup>th</sup> March 2005 until 6.00 p.m. on Friday 18<sup>th</sup> March 2005 or until the resurfacing work is completed, whichever is the earlier.
