CRIMINAL JUSTICE ACT 2001 (APPOINTED DAY) (No. 7) ORDER 2005

Laid before Tynwald: 19th April 2005

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Home Affairs by section 64(2) of the Criminal Justice Act 2001(a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Criminal Justice Act 2001 (Appointed Day) (No. 7) Order 2005.

2. Section 37 of and Schedule 7 to the Criminal Justice Act 2001 shall come into operation on 1st May 2005.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order)

This Order brings into force section 37 of and Schedule 7 to the Criminal Justice Act 2001 which enables criminal courts to impose attendance centre orders.

The Criminal Justice Act 2001 (Appointed Day) (No.1) Order brought most of the provisions of the 2001 Act into force with the exception of those which required regulations or rules of Court to be made.

Appointed Day Orders No. 2 to No. 6 brought into force those provisions relating to curfew orders, registration of sex offenders, drug and alcohol testing in the IoM Prison, the seizure of cash which represents proceeds of crime and reparation orders.
