**THE FORESTRY ACT 1984**

**THE FORESTRY (GENERAL) (AMENDMENT) BYELAWS 2005**

*Approved by Tynwald 20th April 2005*

*Coming into operation 22nd April 2005*

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry by section 7 of the Forestry Act 1984<sup>1</sup>, and of all other enabling powers, the following Byelaws are hereby made:-

**1. Citation and commencement**

These Byelaws may be cited as the Forestry (General) (Amendment) Byelaws 2005 and, subject to section 7(2) of the Forestry Act 1984, shall come into operation on the 22nd April 2005.

**2. Interpretation**

In these Byelaws, “the principal Byelaws” means the Forestry (General) Byelaws 2003<sup>2</sup>.

**3. Amendment of SD 2/03**

In the principal Byelaws, for “the Sulby Claddagh Byelaws 1994” substitute –  
“the Sulby Claddagh Byelaws 2003<sup>3</sup> or the Ayres National Nature Reserve (Department Land) Byelaws 2005<sup>4</sup>”

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Byelaws.)*

These Byelaws amend the Forestry (General) Byelaws 2003 by removing from their scope land vested in the Department at the Ayres National Nature Reserve, which is now the subject of a separate Byelaw to regulate its use by the public, and also amends reference to the Sulby Claddagh Byelaws 2003, which were amended by the Sulby Claddagh Byelaws 2004.
