



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**LEZAYRE ROAD (RAMSEY)
(TEMPORARY IMPOSITION OF 20 MPH SPEED LIMIT)
ORDER 2006**

Coming into Operation: 1 February 2006

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 24 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985¹, and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made :-

1. Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the Lezayre Road (Ramsey) (Temporary Imposition of 20mph Speed Limit) Order 2006 and shall come into operation at 6.00am on Wednesday 1 February 2006.

2. Temporary imposition of speed limit

No person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform cause any vehicle to travel at a speed in excess of 20 mph on that section of Lezayre Road, Ramsey from a point 100 metres east of Crossags Lane to a point 100 metres west of Crossags Lane, Ramsey.

3. Duration

This Order shall continue in force from 6.00am on Wednesday 1 February 2006 until 6.00pm on Friday 26 May 2006 or until the work to extend Ramsey Grammar School is completed, whichever is the earlier.
