



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**A18 MOUNTAIN ROAD (LONAN/BRADDAN/ONCHAN)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2006**

Coming into Operation: 6 March 2006

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985¹, and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 to the Act as required by Section 3(1) and after having been satisfied that Section 1(8) of the Act does not apply, the following Order is hereby made:-

1. Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the A18 Mountain Road (Lonan/Braddan/Onchan) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 2006 and shall come into operation from 6.00am on Monday 6 March 2006.

2. Closure of road to vehicular traffic

Subject to Article 3, no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a constable in uniform, cause any vehicle to proceed on that section of the A18 Mountain Road, Lonan/Braddan/Onchan, between its junction with the B10 Brandywell Road and its junction with the B12 Creg Ny Baa Road.

3. Exemptions

Article 2 does not apply to a person or vehicle requiring access to premises or land adjacent to the road specified in Article 2 or to -

- (1) a vehicle engaged in any of the following operations :
 - (a) works in land or premises adjacent to the road specified in Article 2;
 - (b) works in the road specified in Article 2 authorised by statutory provisions;
 - or
 - (c) in the service of a local authority or the Department of Transport in pursuance of any statutory functions in the road or in adjacent land or premises if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes on any other road; or
- (2) a vehicle being used in the course of duty for the police, fire brigade, ambulance or coastguard service; or

- (3) a vehicle for which a permit issued by the Department of Transport for its use in the road, at a time or for a purpose specified in the permit; or
- (4) such vehicular traffic as may be authorised by the Department.

4. Duration

The Order shall be in force from 6.00am on Monday 6 March 2006 6.00pm on Friday 28 April 2006 or until the realignment and reconstruction work is completed, whichever is the earlier.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to prohibit vehicular traffic from proceeding on a section of the A18 Mountainl Road, in the Parishes of Lonan, Braddan and Onchan, whilst realignment and reconstruction work is being undertaken.

An alternative route will be via the A3 Ramsey to Castletown Road or the A2 Ramsey to Douglas Road.

No access will be available to the A18 at Windy Corner from the U31 Nobles Park Road, Lonan
