



HIGHWAYS ACT 1986

**BOROUGH OF DOUGLAS (BRAY HILL FOOTWAY)
(TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2006**

Coming into Operation: 14 February 2006

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 38 of the Highways Act 1986¹ and all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

1. Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the Borough of Douglas (Bray Hill Footway) (Temporary Closure) Order 2006 and shall come into operation at 6.00am on Tuesday 14 February 2006.

2. Closure of footway to pedestrian traffic

Subject to Article 3, no person shall proceed on that section of the footway on the north eastern side of Bray Hill in the Borough of Douglas, from its junction with Ballaquayle Road to its junction with Stoney Road, Douglas.

3. Duration

The Order shall continue in force from 6.00am on Tuesday 14 February 2006 until 6.00pm on Tuesday 28 March 2006 or until the lighting work is completed, whichever is the earlier.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to prohibit pedestrian traffic from proceeding on the section of footway on Bray Hill, Douglas between Ballaquayle Road and Stoney Road, whilst lighting work is being undertaken.
