**POST OFFICE ACT 1993
POST OFFICE (INLAND POST) (AMENDMENT NO.1) SCHEME 2006**

**Laid before Tynwald: 21st March 2006
Coming into Operation: 3rd April 2006**

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Isle of Man Post Office by Sections 13 and 59(2) of the Post Office Act 1993 (a) and all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Department of Trade & Industry, the following Scheme is hereby made :-

Citation and commencement

1. This Scheme may be cited as the Post Office (Inland Post) (Amendment No.1) Scheme 2006 and shall come into operation on 3rd April 2006.

Amendments

2. The Isle of Man Post Office Authority (Inland Post) Regulations 1977 (b) (in this Scheme referred to as "the principal regulations") are amended in accordance with Schedule 1.

Revocations

3. The public documents mentioned in Schedule 2 are revoked to the extent specified in the third column of that Schedule.

2. In Schedule 2 (Postal Facilities) -

- (a) Entry No. 1 (Business Reply and Freepost Licence Fee) for “£66.00 per annum” substitute “£70.00 per annum”;
- (b) Entry No. 3 (Recorded Delivery) for “65p plus postage” substitute “68p plus postage”;
- (c) Entry No.6 (Private Boxes) – the whole entry shall be deleted and substituted by:

“6. Private Boxes. (For the purposes of this paragraph, “Postal Packet” means any item transmitted by post). Provision by the Post Office of a Private Box (such box being, when available, a box for which the renter or his agent holds the identification card as supplied by the Post Office) at a delivery office serving the address of the renter, in which postal packets are placed to await collection by the addressee or his agent instead of being delivered by postmen at the place of address, or from which postal packets can, at the request of the addressee, be delivered to the addressee’s place of address as an additional facility to the provision of a Private Box. *

- A. For initial period of one year or less:
- 1) a box fee, that is to say, where the postal packets are to be made available for collection by the addressee or his agent at or after time of commencement of the first delivery, or the time of opening the Post Office to the public (whichever is the earlier) and before the time of closing the Post Office to the public:
 - a) Residential Private Box for reception of all classes of postal packets the annual fee of £76.00
 - b) Business Private Box for reception of all classes of postal packets the annual fee of £130.00;
 - 2) delivery fee, payable in addition to the fees specified in sub paragraphs (1)(a) and (1)(b) where an addressee requests delivery by the Post Office to his normal address:
 - a) Residential Private Box the annual fee of £76.00
 - b) Business Private Box the annual fee of £130.00;
 - 3) transfer fee, payable in addition to the fees referred to in (1) and, where applicable, in (2) and (3), where an addressee requests postal packets addressed to the box be delivered to his place of address, or where an addressee requests placement by the Post Office of postal packets addressed to his actual place of address into the box to await collection:
 - a) Residential Private Box the annual fee of £76.00
 - b) Business Private Box the annual fee of £130.00
- B. For each subsequent year or part thereof the fees payable under A above will be applicable.

** In certain cases no actual box will be provided and postal packets will be held by the Postmaster in a suitable place to await collection and in such cases the provisions of this paragraph will have effect as if the provision of such a suitable place were the provision of a box. ” ;*

(d) Entry No. 8 (Redirection by the Post Office) shall be deleted and substituted by –

(e) Entry No. 10 (Temporary Retention/Keepsafe) shall be deleted and substituted by

" With-holding of postal packets from delivery at the request of the addressee:

a)	for a period not exceeding 2 weeks	£ 9.00

c)	for a period not exceeding 4 weeks	£16.00
d)	for a period not exceeding 8 weeks	£19.00
e)	for a period not exceeding 12 weeks	£26.00 "

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Scheme)

1. This Scheme amends the Isle of Man Post Office Authority (Inland Post) Regulations 1977 by -
 - (a) increasing the charges for posting a local letter and letters to the United Kingdom, the Channel Islands and the Irish Republic;
 - (b) increasing the fees for Freepost and Business Reply licences, Recorded Delivery, Private Boxes, Redirection of Mail and Temporary Retention/Keepsafe; and
 - (c) increasing the Special Delivery and compensation fees.
2. These changes take effect from 3rd April 2006.
