



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**PARLIAMENT STREET (RAMSEY)  
(TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2006**

*Coming into Operation: 2 March 2006*

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985<sup>1</sup>, and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 to the Act as required by Section 3(1), the following Order is hereby made:-

**1. Citation and commencement**

This Order may be cited as the Parliament Street (Ramsey) (Temporary Suspension of Parking Places) Order 2006 and shall come into operation at 6.00am on Thursday 2 March 2006.

**2. Temporary suspension of parking**

No person shall cause any vehicle to be parked on the south western side of Parliament Street, Ramsey, adjacent to numbers 13-15 Parliament Street.

**3. Duration**

This Order shall continue in force from 6.00am on Thursday 2 March 2006 until 6.00pm on Tuesday 14 March 2006 or until the work on the shop front is completed, whichever is the earlier.
