



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**BOROUGH OF DOUGLAS (TYNWALD STREET)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2006**

*Coming into Operation: 14 March 2006*

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985<sup>1</sup>, and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 to the Act as required by Section 3(1), and having been satisfied that Section 1(8) of the Act does not apply, the following Order is hereby made:-

**1. Citation and commencement**

This Order may be cited as the Borough of Douglas (Tynwald Street) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 2006 and shall come into operation from 9.30am on Tuesday 14 March 2006.

2) In this Order –

“the Act ” means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985; and

“the Department” means the Department of Transport

**2. Closure of road to vehicular traffic**

Subject to Article 3, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed on that section of Tynwald Street, Douglas, between its junction with Westmoreland Road and its junction with Orry Street.

**3. Exemption**

Article 2 does not apply to a vehicle requiring access to premises or land adjacent to the road specified in Article 2 or to –

(1) a vehicle engaged in any of the following operations –

(a) works in land or premises adjacent to the road specified in Article 2;



- (b) works in the road specified in Article 2 authorised by statutory provisions;  
or
  - (c) in the service of the Department or a local authority in pursuance of any statutory functions in the road or in adjacent land or premises if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes on any other road; or
- (1) a vehicle being used in the course of duty for the police, fire brigade, ambulance or other emergency service; or
  - (2) a vehicle for which the driver holds a permit issued by the Department for its use in the road, at a time or for a purpose specified in the permit; or
  - (3) such vehicular traffic as may be authorised by the Department.

#### 4. Duration

The Order shall continue in force from 9.30am until 3.00pm each day from Tuesday 14 March 2006 until Friday 17 March 2006 or until the lifting work is completed, whichever is the earlier.

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not a part of the Order)*

The effect of this Order is to prohibit traffic from proceeding along a section of Tynwald Street in the Borough of Douglas whilst lifting work is being undertaken.

An alternate route will be via Allan Street and Peveril Street, Douglas.
