



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**STANLEY MOUNT EAST (RAMSEY)
(TEMPORARY INTRODUCTION OF ONE-WAY SYSTEM) ORDER 2006**

Coming into Operation: 1 April 2006

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department by Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985¹ and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 to the Act as required by Section 3(1), the following Order is hereby made:-

1. Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the Stanley Mount East (Ramsey) (Temporary Introduction of One-Way System) Order 2006 and shall come into operation at 6.00am on Saturday 1 April 2006.

2. One-Way Traffic

No person shall, except upon the direction or with permission of a police constable in uniform, cause any vehicle to proceed otherwise than in a southerly direction on Stanley Mount East, Ramsey, between its junction with Queens Drive East and its junction with Stanley Mount West.

3. Duration

This Order shall continue in force from 6.00am on Saturday 1 April 2006 until 6.00pm on Friday 1 September 2006 or until the construction work is completed, whichever is the earlier.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to temporarily require vehicular traffic to proceed in a southerly direction only over a section of Stanley Mount East, Ramsey, whilst construction work is carried out.
