



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**QUEENS DRIVE EAST (RAMSEY)
(TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2006**

Coming into Operation: 1 April 2006

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985¹, and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 to the Act as required by Section 3(1), the following Order is hereby made:-

1. Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the Queens Drive East (Ramsey) (Temporary Suspension of Parking Places) Order 2006 and shall come into operation at 6.00am on Saturday 1 April 2006.

2. Temporary suspension of parking

No person shall cause any vehicle to be parked on that section of the south side of Queens Drive East, Ramsey, between its junction with Stanley Mount West and its junction with Stanley Mount East.

3. Duration

This Order shall continue in force until 6.00pm on Friday 1 September 2006 or until the construction work is completed, whichever is the earlier.
