THE SOCIAL SECURITY LEGISLATION (APPLICATION)
(AMENDMENT) (No. 2) ORDER 2006

Coming into operation in accordance with Article 1

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Health and Social Security by section 1 of the Social Security Act 2000(a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Social Security Legislation (Application) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order 2006 and shall, subject to section 2(1) of the Social Security Act 2000, come into force on 1st May 2006.

Amendment of the Social Security Legislation (Application) (No. 12) Order 1992

2. (1) Amend the Social Security Legislation (Application) (No. 12) Order 1992(b) in accordance with the following paragraph.

(2) In Schedule 3 (the exceptions, adaptations and modifications subject to which the Occupational Pension Schemes (Preservation of Benefit) Regulations 1991(c)) have effect in the Isle of Man) after the entry relating to regulation 9 insert –

“12	Transfer of member’s accrued rights without consent	In paragraph (5)(a) for “section 47 of the Pensions Act 1995” substitute “section 17(1)(b) of the Retirement Benefits Schemes Act 2000 (of Tynwald)”.”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order, which comes into force on 1st May 2006, makes a minor amendment to the Occupational Pension Schemes (Preservation of Benefit) Regulations 1991 (as they have effect in the Isle of Man) to reflect the passing of responsibility for the regulation of certain matters relating to occupational pension schemes from the Department of Health and Social Security to the Insurance and Pensions Authority.
