



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**KING EDWARD ROAD (ONCHAN/DOUGLAS)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) (NO 2) ORDER 2006**

*Coming into Operation: 11 March 2006*

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985<sup>1</sup>, and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 to the Act as required by Section 3(1), and having been satisfied that Section 1(8) of the Act does not apply, the following Order is hereby made:-

**1. Citation and commencement**

This Order may be cited as the King Edward Road (Onchan/Douglas) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) (No 2) Order 2006 and shall come into operation at 12.01am on Saturday 11 March 2006.

2) In this Order –

“the Act ” means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985; and

“the Department” means the Department of Transport

**2. Closure of road to vehicular traffic**

Subject to Article 3, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed on that section of King Edward Road, Onchan/Douglas, between its junction with Summerhill and its junction with Imperial Terrace/Port Jack.

**3. Exemption**

Article 2 does not apply to a vehicle requiring access to premises or land adjacent to the road specified in Article 2 or to –

(1) a vehicle engaged in any of the following operations –

(a) works in land or premises adjacent to the road specified in Article 2;

- (b) works in the road specified in Article 2 authorised by statutory provisions;  
or
  - (c) in the service of the Department or a local authority in pursuance of any statutory functions in the road or in adjacent land or premises if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes on any other road; or
- (1) a vehicle being used in the course of duty for the police, fire brigade, ambulance or other emergency service; or
  - (2) a vehicle for which the driver holds a permit issued by the Department for its use in the road, at a time or for a purpose specified in the permit; or
  - (3) such vehicular traffic as may be authorised by the Department.

#### 4. Duration

The Order shall continue in force until 11.59pm on Sunday 12 March 2006 or until the work to remove a hoarding is completed, whichever is the earlier.

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not a part of the Order)*

The effect of this Order is to prohibit vehicular traffic from proceeding along a section of King Edward Road, Onchan/Douglas, whilst work to remove a hoarding is being undertaken.

An alternative route for traffic will be via Summerhill, Strathallan Road, Hague Crescent, Imperial Terrace and Port Jack, Onchan/Douglas.
