



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**BOROUGH OF DOUGLAS (MYRTLE STREET)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 2006**

Coming into Operation: 27 March 2006

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985¹, and all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 to the Act as required by Section 3(1), the following Order is hereby made :-

1. Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the Borough of Douglas (Myrtle Street) (Temporary Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2006 and shall come into operation at 6.00am on Monday 27 March 2006

2. Restriction of vehicles waiting

Save as provided in Article 3 no person shall, except upon the direction of or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait, other than Disabled Persons' Vehicles, on that section of Myrtle Street, Douglas from a point 47 metres southwest of its junction with Bucks Road for a distance of 7.2 metres.

3. Duration

This Order shall continue in force from 6.00am on Monday 27 March 2006 until 6.00pm on Friday 30 June 2006

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to prohibit all vehicles other than Disabled Persons' Vehicles from waiting on a section of the south east side of Myrtle Street, in the Borough of Douglas.
