**A14 SULBY GLEN ROAD (LEZAYRE)  
(TEMPORARY IMPOSITION OF SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2007**

*Coming into Operation: 3 February 2007*

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 24 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985<sup>1</sup>, and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made :-

**1. Citation and commencement**

This Order may be cited as the A14 Sulby Glen Road (Lezayre) (Temporary Imposition of Speed Limit) Order 2007 and shall come into operation at 6.00 am on Saturday 3 February 2007.

**2. Temporary imposition of speed limit**

No person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform cause any vehicle to travel at a speed in excess of 30 mph on that section of the A14 Sulby Glen Road, Lezayre, from its junction with the A3 Kirk Michael to Ramsey Road to the cattle grid situated after the property Struan Thie, a distance of 1.1 miles.

**3. Duration**

This Order shall continue in force until 6.00 pm on Thursday 2 August 2007.
