



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**BOROUGH OF DOUGLAS (CENTRAL PROMENADE)
(TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2007**

Coming into Operation: 23 January 2007

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985¹, and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 to the Act as required by Section 3(1), the following Order is hereby made:-

1. Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the Borough of Douglas (Central Promenade) (Temporary Suspension of Parking Places) Order 2007 and shall come into operation from 6.00am on Tuesday 23 January 2007.

2. Temporary suspension of parking

No person shall cause any vehicle to be parked on that section of landward side of Central Promenade, Douglas, from a point abutting the telephone box fronting Protours kiosk for a distance of approximately 12 metres in a south-westerly direction, and on that section from the boundary of the Empress Hotel and former Crescent Leisure Centre for a distance of approximately 12 metres in a northerly direction.

3. Duration

This Order shall continue in force from 6.00am on Tuesday 23 January 2007 until 6.00pm on Monday 23 July 2007 or until the construction work is completed, whichever is the earlier.
