



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**BOROUGH OF DOUGLAS (HARRIS PROMENADE) (NORTHBOUND CARRIAGEWAY)
(TEMPORARY IMPOSITION OF 20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2007**

Coming into Operation: 29 January 2007

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 24 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985¹, and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made :-

1. Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the Borough of Douglas (Harris Promenade) (Northbound Carriageway) (Temporary Imposition of 20mph Speed Limit) Order 2007 and shall come into operation at 5.00pm on Monday 29 January 2007.

2. Temporary imposition of speed limit

No person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform cause any vehicle to travel at a speed in excess of 20 mph on the northbound carriageway of Harris Promenade, Douglas, between Greensills Corner and Broadway.

3. Duration

This Order shall continue in force until 6.00 p.m. on Sunday 29 July 2007 or until the work on the Villa Marina Arcade has been completed, whichever is the earlier.
