



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**STATION ROAD (PORT ERIN)  
(TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF DISABLED PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2007**

*Coming into Operation: 8 February 2007*

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985<sup>1</sup>, and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 to the Act as required by Section 3(1), the following Order is hereby made:-

**1. Citation and commencement**

This Order may be cited as the Station Road (Port Erin) (Temporary Suspension of Disabled Parking Places) Order 2007 and shall come into operation at 8.30am on Thursday 8 February 2007.

**2. Temporary suspension of parking**

No person shall cause any vehicle to be parked on the disabled parking spaces on Station Road, Port Erin, adjacent to the boundary between the Isle of Man Bank and the Commissioners' office.

**3. Duration**

This Order shall continue in force between 8.30am and 5.00pm each day from Thursday 8 February 2007 until Friday 9 February 2007 or until the Commissioners' office relocation is completed, whichever is the earlier.

**4. Exemption**

Article 2 does not apply to a vehicle involved in the Commissioners' office relocation.
