



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**BIRCHAM AVENUE (RAMSEY)
(TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2007**

Coming into Operation: 19 February 2007

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985¹, and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 to the Act as required by Section 3(1), the following Order is hereby made:-

1. Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the Bircham Avenue (Ramsey) (Temporary Suspension of Parking Places) Order 2007 and shall come into operation at 6.00am on Monday 19 February 2007.

2. Temporary suspension of parking

No person shall cause any vehicle to be parked on either side of that section of Bircham Avenue between its junction with Lezayre Road and a point abutting the property known as Bircham House, and on either side of that section between No 1 and No 4 Bircham Avenue, Ramsey.

3. Duration

This Order shall continue in force until 6.00pm on Saturday 3 March 2007 or until the carriageway reconstruction and overlay work is completed, whichever is the earlier.
