**THE CONTROLLED MACHINES (PRESCRIBED AMOUNTS)
REGULATIONS 2007**

Coming into operation

1st April 2007

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Isle of Man Gambling Control Commissioners by section 1(4) and (5) of the Gaming (Amendment) Act 1984¹, and of all other enabling powers, the following Regulations are hereby made:-

1. Citation and commencement

These Regulations may be cited as the Controlled Machines (Prescribed Amounts) Regulations 2007 and, subject to section 16 of the Gaming (Amendment) Act 1984, shall come into operation on the 1st April 2007.

2. Prescribed amounts

The amounts prescribed for the purposes of section 1(4) of the Gaming (Amendment) Act 1984 are -

(a) for the purpose of section 1(4)(a), (maximum charge for play) -

- (i) in the case of a prize machine, 50p;
- (ii) in any other case, £2.00;

(b) for the purpose of section 1(4)(c), (maximum prize), £35.00

3. Revocation

The Controlled Machines (Prescribed Amounts) Regulations 2003² are revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations increase the maximum prize payable on prize machines from £25 to £35, and increase the maximum stake for a prize machine from 30p to 50p. The stake for non prize controlled machines remains at £2.
