INSURANCE (AMENDMENT) (FEES) REGULATIONS 2007

Laid before Tynwald

20th March 2007

Coming into operation

1st April 2007

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Insurance and Pensions Authority by sections 7 and 32 of, and Schedule 4 to, the Insurance Act 1986¹, and of all other enabling powers, and having consulted the Treasury, and such other organisations and persons as appear to it to be likely to be affected, the following Regulations are made:—

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Insurance (Amendment) (Fees) Regulations 2007 and shall come into operation on the 1st April 2007.

Amendment to 1986 Regulations

2. In regulation 16 of the Insurance Regulations 1986², for paragraph (1) there shall be substituted the following paragraph –

“(1) For the purposes of section 7 of the Act, the following fees are prescribed:-

- (a) in respect of authorisation, the fee is £1,500;
- (b) the annual fee is:-
 - (i) in the case of an insurer which is authorised to carry on insurance business within classes 1 and 2, £14,000, or
 - (ii) in the case of any other insurer, £3,500,and is payable on 6 April each year.”.

Revocation

3. Regulation 2 of the Insurance (Amendment) (Fees) Regulations 2003³ is revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the regulations)

These regulations make an amendment to the Insurance Regulations 1986. In particular they increase the annual fee payable by authorised insurance companies and, by extension, to non-EU domiciled permit holders. The initial authorisation fee of £1,500 remains unaltered.
