



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**BOROUGH OF DOUGLAS (FORT STREET/LORD STREET)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2007**

*Coming into Operation: 18 February 2007*

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985<sup>1</sup>, and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 to the Act as required by Section 3(1), and having been satisfied that Section 1(8) of the Act does not apply, the following Order is hereby made:-

**1. Citation and commencement**

This Order may be cited as the Borough of Douglas (Fort Street/Lord Street) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 2007 and shall come into operation from 8.00am on Sunday 18 February 2007

2) In this Order –

“the Act ” means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985; and

“the Department” means the Department of Transport

**2. Closure of road to vehicular traffic**

Subject to Article 3, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in an easterly direction on that section of Fort Street/Lord Street, Douglas, between its junction with Victoria Street and its junction with Lord Street/Parade Street.

**3. Exemption**

Article 2 does not apply to a vehicle requiring access to premises or land adjacent to the road specified in Article 2 or to –

(1) a vehicle engaged in any of the following operations –

(a) works in land or premises adjacent to the road specified in Article 2;

(b) works in the road specified in Article 2 authorised by statutory provisions;  
or

(c) in the service of the Department or a local authority in pursuance of any statutory functions in the road or in adjacent land or premises if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes on any other road; or

- (2) a vehicle being used in the course of duty for the police, fire brigade, ambulance or other emergency service; or
- (3) a vehicle for which the driver holds a permit issued by the Department for its use in the road, at a time or for a purpose specified in the permit; or
- (4) such vehicular traffic as may be authorised by the Department.

**5. Duration**

The Order shall continue in force from 8.00am on until 12 Noon on Sunday 18 February 2007 or until the roofing work is completed, whichever is the earlier.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not a part of the Order)*

The effect of this Order is to prohibit vehicular traffic from proceeding in an easterly direction on a section of Fort Street/Lord Street, in the Borough of Douglas, whilst roofing work is being undertaken.

An alternative route will be via Victoria Street or Lord Street.
