



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**BOROUGH OF DOUGLAS (BATH PLACE)
(TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF LOADING BAY) ORDER 2007**

Coming into Operation: 20 February 2007

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985¹, and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 to the Act as required by Section 3(1), the following Order is hereby made:-

1. Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the Borough of Douglas (Bath Place) (Temporary Suspension of Loading Bay) Order 2007 and shall come into operation from 6.00am on Tuesday 20 February 2007.

2. Temporary suspension of loading bay

No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the loading bay situated on the northern side of Bath Place, fronting Lloyds TSB, Douglas.

3. Duration

This Order shall continue in force from 6.00am on Tuesday 20 February 2007 until 6.00pm on Monday 20 August 2007 or until the Sea Terminal Improvement Scheme work is completed, whichever is the earlier.
