SUPERANNUATION ACT 1984

HOSPICE CARE SUPERANNUATION (AMENDMENT) SCHEME 2007

Approved by Tynwald 12th July 2007

Coming into operation in accordance with article 1

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Civil Service Commission by section 2 and 12 of the Superannuation Act 1984¹, and of all other enabling powers, (including, for the avoidance of doubt, section 28 of the Interpretation Act 1976), the following Scheme of amendment is hereby made:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Scheme may be cited as the Hospice Care Superannuation (Amendment) Scheme 2007 and subject to section 12(1) of the Act, this Scheme shall be deemed to have come into operation, on the same date and in the same manner as the National Health Service Superannuation Scheme 2007.

Amendment of 2001 Scheme

2. In paragraph 1(2) of the Hospice Care Superannuation Scheme 2001², for the definition of “the Manx NHS Scheme” substitute –

“the Manx NHS Scheme” means the National Health Service Superannuation Scheme 2007³;”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Scheme.)

This Scheme is made under the Superannuation Act 1984. It amends the Hospice Care Superannuation Scheme 2001 so as to replace the definition of "the NHS Scheme" to take account of the revocation and replacement of the NHS Superannuation Scheme 1997 by the NHS Superannuation Scheme 2007.

The clinical staff of Hospice Care are superannuable on the same basis as NHS clinical staff.
