REGISTRATION OF BIRTHS AND DEATHS (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2012

Coming into Operation: 17th September 2012

The Clerk of the Rolls makes the following Regulations under section 43 of the Civil Registration Act 1984¹.

1 Title

These Regulations are the Registration of Births and Deaths (Amendment) Regulations 2012.

2 Commencement

These Regulations come into operation on 17th September 2012.

3 Amendment of 2011 Regulations

In regulation 39(1)(b)(ii) (reference to coroner) of the Registration of Births and Deaths Regulations 2011², for “14 days” substitute “28 days”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Registration of Births and Deaths Regulations 2011 so as to require a registrar to report a death to the Coroner of Inquests if the deceased was not seen by the certifying medical practitioner within 28 days (instead of 14 days) before death. They reinstate the requirement of regulation 47 of the Registration of Births, Deaths and Marriages Regulations 1984.
