Cash in Postal Packets Act 2013

CASH IN POSTAL PACKETS ACT 2013 (APPOINTED DAY) (NO. 2) ORDER 2013

Laid before Tynwald: 16 April 2013
Coming into Operation: 1 June 2013

The Treasury makes the following Order under section 2 of the Cash in Postal Packets Act 2013¹.

1 Title

This Order is the Cash in Postal Packets Act 2013 (Appointed Day) (No. 2) Order 2013.

2 Commencement of remaining provisions

The following provisions of the Cash in Postal Packets Act 2013 come into operation on 1 June 2013-

- (a) sections 3 to 12;
- (b) for all remaining purposes, sections 13 and 15²;
- (c) section 14;
- (d) section 16; and
- (e) sections 18 and 19.

*EXPLANATORY NOTE**(This note is not part of the Order)*

This Order designates the 1 June 2013 as the day on which the remainder of the Cash in Postal Packets Act 2013 (“the Act”) comes into operation.

Sections 1 and 2 of the Act came into operation upon the announcement of Royal Assent in Tynwald.

The Cash in Postal Packets Act 2013 (Appointed Day) (No. 1) Order 2013³ brought section 17 of the Act into operation on 27 March 2013 which enabled the Department of Home Affairs to make a code of practice relating to search of postal packets permitted under section 43A⁴ of the Proceeds of Crime Act 2008. Consequently, sections 13 and 15 of the Act were brought into operation for certain purposes of that Order. This Order brings sections 13 and 15 of the Act into operation on 1 June 2013 for all remaining purposes.
