Food (Emergency Provisions) Act 1986

FOOD (EMERGENCY PROVISIONS) (AMNESIC SHELLFISH POISONING) REVOCATION ORDER 2015

Laid before Tynwald: 17 February 2015
Coming into Operation: in accordance with Article 2

Whereas in the opinion of the Department of Environment, Food and Agriculture there no longer exists in those parts of the area of sea within the British fishery limits designated by the Food (Emergency Provisions) (Amnesic Shellfish Poisoning) (No. 3) Order 2014¹ shellfish likely to create a hazard to human health through human consumption of it.

The Department of Environment, Food and Agriculture makes the following Order under section 1(1) of the Food (Emergency Provisions) Act 1986.

1 Title

This Order is the Food (Emergency Provisions) (Amnesic Shellfish Poisoning) Revocation Order 2015.

2 Commencement

This Order comes into operation at 0001 hours on 14 January 2015.

3 Revocation

The Food (Emergency Provisions) (Amnesic Shellfish Poisoning) (No. 3) Order 2014 is revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE***(This note is not part of the Order)***

This Order revokes the Food (Emergency Provisions) (Amnesic Shellfish Poisoning) (No. 3) Order 2014 which designated two specific areas of sea within which were found scallops containing toxin which causes amnesic shellfish poisoning. The (No. 3) Order also prohibited the taking of scallops in the designated areas and various other activities designed to prevent the human consumption of such scallops.

The effect of this Order is to remove the prohibition in respect of the two areas of sea known as areas IS9 and IS14 which are designated in the Schedule to the (No. 3) Order.
