## **PUBLIC SERVICES COMMISSION ACT 2015 (APPOINTED DAY) (NO. 1) ORDER 2015**

*Laid before Tynwald*

*17 March 2015*

The Council of Ministers makes the following Order under section 2(1) of the Public Services Commission Act 2015<sup>1</sup>.

### **1 Title**

This Order is the Public Services Commission Act 2015 (Appointed Day) (No. 1) Order 2015.

### **2 Interpretation**

In this Order —

- (a) “the Act” means the *Public Services Commission Act 2015*; and
- (b) a reference without more to a numbered section or Schedule is a reference to the section of, or Schedule to the Act which is so numbered.

### **3 Provisions commenced on 6 February 2015, transitional modifications, savings and exception**

- (1) The following provisions come into operation on 6 February 2015 —
  - (a) section 3(1), other than the definition of “**stationed employer**”;
  - (b) section 4;
  - (c) section 5(1)(a), (c) and (d) and (2); and
  - (d) sections 5(3), 6 and 11 so far as referable to the provisions mentioned in sub-paragraphs (a) and (b).
- (2) Section 10, so far as referable to the provisions commenced by paragraph (1), comes into operation on 6 February 2015.
- (3) In consequence of the provision made by paragraph (2) —
  - (a) paragraph 10(1) and (2), and

- (b) paragraph 16,  
of the Schedule come into operation on 6 February 2015, but subject to  
the transitional provision article 4.

#### 4 Transitional modifications

- (1) Until section 5 comes into operation for all purposes, references in  
subsection (1)(a) (c) and (d) to employees of the Commission (however  
expressed) are to be read as references to persons employed by —
- (a) persons employed by the Civil Service Commission; and
  - (b) persons employed by any of the following—
    - (i) a Department,
    - (ii) a Statutory Board; or
    - (iii) an office of the Government,who are not members of the Isle of Man Civil Service.
- (2) Until section 10 comes into operation for all purposes —
- (a) paragraph 10(2) of the Schedule is modified as if the words to be  
substituted by that article were instead to be inserted as a new  
paragraph (ea) in section 1(2);
  - (b) paragraph 16 of the Schedule is modified as if for everything  
following “2007” there were substituted —  
| **ca** after “section 5 of the *Civil Service Act 1990*” insert “or section 10 of the  
| *Public Services Commission Act 2015*” **ca**.
- (3) For the avoidance of doubt, nothing in paragraph (2)(a) of this article  
entitles a person who holds the offices of chairman the Civil Service  
Commission and chairperson of the Public Services Commission to two  
annual sums under section 1(2) of the Payment of Members’ Expenses  
Act 1989 in respect of those offices.
