Harbours Act 2010

HARBOUR FACILITIES (CHARGES) REGULATIONS 2015

Approved by Tynwald: 17 March 2015
Coming into Operation: 1 April 2015

The Department of Infrastructure makes the following Regulations under section 38(2) of the Harbours Act 2010.

1 Title

These Regulations are the Harbour Facilities (Charges) Regulations 2015.

2 Commencement

If approved by Tynwald, these Regulations come into operation on 1 April 2015¹.

3 Application

- (1) These Regulations apply charges in respect of facilities provided by the Department for vessels, passengers and goods using a harbour.
- (2) Any charges payable are calculated in accordance with the Schedule.

4 Exemptions

Regulation 3(1) does not apply to officers of the Customs and Excise Division of the Treasury.

5 Revocation

The Harbour Facilities (Charges) Regulations 2014² are revoked.
