BAIE NY CARRICKEY (RESTRICTIONS ON FISHING FOR LOBSTER AND CRAB) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2015

Laid before Tynwald: 17 March 2015
Coming into Operation: 1 April 2015

The Department of Environment, Food and Agriculture makes the following Regulations under section 36 to 38 and 45 of the Fisheries Act 2012.

1 Title

These Regulations are the Baie ny Carrickey (Restrictions on Fishing for Lobster and Crab) (Amendment) Regulations 2015.

2 Commencement

These Regulations come into operation on 1 April 2015.

3 Amendment of SD 0379/13

- (1) The Baie Ny Carrickey (Restrictions on Fishing for Lobster and Crab) Regulations 2013¹ shall be amended as follows.
- (2) In regulation 6(a) for “88” substitute “90”.
- (3) After regulation 6 insert-

6A Maximum size limits

The maximum size limit in respect of a lobster which may be landed from the Bay is 120 millimetres carapace length. **6B**.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Baie Ny Carrickey (Restrictions on Fishing for Lobster and Crab) Regulations 2013.

They increase the minimum carapace length from 88 millimetres to 90 millimetres in respect of lobsters that can be taken from the Bay.

They also set the maximum carapace length in respect of a lobster that may be taken from the Bay to 120 millimetres.
