EMPLOYMENT OF SECURITY STAFF (ON-LICENSED PREMISES) (AMENDMENT OF APPLICATION FEE) REGULATIONS 2015

Approved by Tynwald: 19 May 2015
Coming into Operation: 1 June 2015

The Department of Home Affairs makes the following Regulations under section 40(1) of the Licensing Act 1995.

1 Title

These Regulations are the Employment of Security Staff (On-licensed Premises) (Amendment of Application Fee) Regulations 2015.

2 Commencement

If approved by Tynwald, these Regulations come into operation on 1 June 2015.¹

3 Interpretation

In these Regulations “the principal Regulations” means the Employment of Security Staff (On-Licensed Premises) Regulations 2002².

4 Amendment of principal Regulations

- (1) In regulation 3(3) (fee for application for entry on the register) of the principal Regulations, for “fee of £85” substitute **£90**.
- (2) In regulation 7(3) (fee for renewal of entry on the register) of the principal Regulations, for “fee of £85” substitute **£90**.

5 Revocation

The Employment of Security Staff (On-licensed Premises) (Amendment of Application Fee) Regulations 2010³ are revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Employment of Security Staff (On-licensed Premises) Regulations 2002 by increasing the application fee for an entry on the register, or the renewal of an entry on the register, from £85 to £90 with effect from 1 June 2015.

These Regulations consequently revoke the Employment of Security Staff (On-licensed Premises) (Amendment of Application Fee) Regulations 2010.
