



## CURRENCY ACT 1992

### CURRENCY (TT LEGENDS) (50 PENCE COINS) ORDER 2015

*Laid before Tynwald: 19<sup>th</sup> May 2015*

*Coming into operation in accordance with article 2*

The Treasury makes this Order under section 5(1) (a), (b) and (d) of the Currency Act 1992<sup>1</sup>.

**1 Title**

This Order is the Currency (TT Legends) (50 Pence Coins) Order 2015.

**2 Commencement**

This Order comes into operation on the day after it is made.

**3 Interpretation**

In this Order “TT Legends coin” means any coin the reverse of which bears a device conforming to the design in Figure 1 in article 7.

**4 Denomination of TT Legends coins**

The permissible denomination of a TT Legends coin is 50 pence.

**5 Face value of TT Legends coins**

The face value of a TT Legends coin is 50 pence.

**6 Design of TT Legends coins**

- 1) TT Legends coin shall be in the shape of an equilateral curved heptagon and have a smooth edge.
- 2) On the obverse of TT Legends coin there shall be —
  - a) An effigy of Her Majesty the Queen by Ian Rank-Broadley

- b) The legend "ISLE OF MAN ELIZABETH II"; and
- c) The year of issue.

**7 Device to be borne by TT Legends coins**

The reverse of a TT Legends coins shall be as shown in figure 1.

**8 Weight, composition, dimension and amount of tolerance and variation of TT Legends coins**

- 1) The weight of TT Legends coin shall (subject to paragraph (4)) be 8g.
- 2) The composition and millesimal fineness of TT Legends Coin shall be 750 copper and 250 nickel.
- 3) The diameter of TT Legends coin from base to apex shall be 30mm.
- 4) The permitted amount of tolerance and variation from the weight prescribed in paragraph (1) shall be 0.35g.
