Road Races Act 1982

TOURIST TROPHY ROAD RACES (SUSPENSION OF ENACTMENTS) ORDER 2015

Made: 18 May 2015
Coming into Operation: 18 May 2015

The Department of Infrastructure makes the following Order under section 7 of the Road Races Act 1982.

1 Title

This Order is the Tourist Trophy Road Races (Suspension of Enactments) Order 2015.

2 Commencement

This Order comes into operation on 18 May 2015.

3 Interpretation

In this Order—

“**Clerk of the Course**”, “**closure period**”, “**Course**” and “**promoter**” have the same meanings as in the Road Race Order;

“**Road Race Order**” means the Tourist Trophy Road Races Order 2015.

4 Suspension of certain road traffic enactments for motor vehicles used in connection with racing

(1) The requirements of Section 5 (using vehicle without licence) and section 12 (display of registration mark) of the Licensing and Registration of Vehicles Act 1985 shall not apply to a motorcycle, with or without a sidecar, taking part in a road race authorised by the Road Race Order or is being driven by a marshal in the course of their duty with the permission of the Clerk of the Course, whilst making certain journeys specified in paragraph (2) during the periods specified in paragraph (3).

(2) The vehicles referred to in paragraph (1) may not be used except on a journey—

- (a) travelling to or from the Sea Terminal and the place where it is kept;
- (b) travelling from the place where it is kept to the start of the Course;
- (c) travelling between points on the Course; or
- (d) travelling from a point on the Course to the place where it is kept;

and is subject to the restrictions and conditions specified in paragraph (3).

- (3) The authorisation applies to daylight hours only between sunrise and sunset and is inclusive of a period commencing 3 hours before any closure period and ending 2 hours after any closure period, provided that period falls within daylight hours.

5 Suspension of certain road traffic enactments for support vehicles

The requirements of Section 5 (using vehicle without licence) and section 12 (display of registration mark) of the Licensing and Registration of Vehicles Act 1985 shall not apply to certain authorised vehicles controlled by the promoter or organiser of the TT Festival or Isle of Man Constabulary for the period specified in article 6.

6 Duration

This Order will be in force for the period 18 May 2015 up to and including 19 June 2015.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order exempts TT competitors, travelling marshals and support vehicles from the provisions of sections 5 (using vehicle without vehicle licence) and 12 (display of registration mark) of the Licensing and Registration of Vehicles Act 1985 when they are making certain journeys and during certain periods during the 2015 TT Festival.
