## **CONTROL OF EMPLOYMENT ACT 2014 (APPOINTED DAY) ORDER 2015**

*Laid before Tynwald:*

*16 June 2015*

The Department of Economic Development makes the following Order under section 2 of the Control of Employment Act 2014.

### **1 Title**

This Order is the Control of Employment Act 2014 (Appointed Day) Order 2015.

### **2 Interpretation**

In this Order “**the 2014 Act**” means the Control of Employment Act 2014.

### **3 Commencement of remaining provisions of 2014 Act**

The remaining provisions of the 2014 Act<sup>1</sup> come into operation –

- (a) for the purposes of making statutory documents under the Act, on the day after this Order is made; and
- (b) for all other purposes on 1 October 2015.

### **4 Transitional saving**

- (1) Despite the repeal of the Control of Employment Act 1975 (“the 1975 Act”) by the relevant entry in Schedule 4 to the 2014 Act, the exemption conferred by paragraph 1 of Schedule 1 to the 1975 Act, so far as it relates to members of the Isle of Man Constabulary, continues to apply until 1 August 2017.
- (2) Accordingly, until 1 August 2017, at the end of paragraph 3(1) of Schedule 1 to the 2014 Act there are to be treated as added the words “or a member of the Isle of Man Constabulary”.

*EXPLANATORY NOTE*

This Order brings into operation the remaining provisions of the Control of Employment Act 2014. Sections 1 and 2 came into operation on the announcement of Royal Assent.

The Order contains a transitional saving in relation to the employment of members of the Isle of Man Constabulary. Such persons will not need work permits until 1 August 2017.
