LIBYA SANCTIONS (AMENDMENT) (NO.2) REGULATIONS 2015

Laid before Tynwald: 22 July 2015
Coming into operation in accordance with regulation 2

The Council of Ministers makes the following Regulations under sections 2B and 2C of the European Communities (Isle of Man) Act 1973.

1 Title

These Regulations are the Libya Sanctions (Amendment) (No.2) Regulations 2015.


2 Commencement

These Regulations come into operation immediately after they are made.

3 Amendment of the Libya Sanctions Regulations 2011

- (1) The Libya Sanctions Regulations 2011¹ are amended as follows.
- (2) In regulation 3, in the definition of the “EU Regulation” —
 - (a) omit “and” immediately following paragraph (p);
 - (b) after paragraph (q) insert —

and

 - (r) Council Regulation (EU) 2015/813² of 26 May 2015 amending Regulation (EU) No 204/2011³ concerning restrictive measures in view of the situation in Libya, .

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations the Libya Sanctions Regulations 2011 (SD 158/11: “the principal Regulations”) to take account of the amendment of Council Regulation (EU) No 204/2011 by Council Regulation (EU) 2015/813 as these EU instruments have effect in the Island by virtue of SD 157/11 (with previous amendments) and SD 2015/0215; respectively.

The principal Regulations established offences and penalties for breaches of Council Regulation (EU) No 204/2011, as applied to the Island by SD 157/11, and they provided for the licencing by Treasury of activities which would otherwise be proscribed.
