PUBLIC SERVICES COMMISSION (CLASSES OF EMPLOYEES) ORDER 2015

*Approved by Tynwald:**23 July 2015**Coming into Operation:**1 September 2015*

The Council of Ministers makes the following Order under section 7(1)(b) of the Public Services Commission Act 2015.

1 Title

This Order is the Public Services Commission (Classes of Employees) Order 2015.

2 Commencement

If approved by Tynwald, this Order comes into operation on 1 September 2015 being the day appointed by the Public Services Commission (Appointed Day (No. 2) and Transitional Provisions) Order 2015 (“the principal appointed day”).

3 Interpretation

In this Order —

“the Act” means the Public Services Commission Act 2015 and a reference to a numbered section (without more) is a reference to the section of the Act so numbered;

“the Commission” means the body established by section 4;

“the principal appointed day” has the meaning given by article 2; and

“public sector employee” has the meaning given in section 3(2) and (3).

4 Classes of public sector employees who are employees of the Commission

(1) For the purposes of section 7 the classes of public sector employees prescribed in paragraphs (2) and (3) are employees of the Commission.

- (2) The class prescribed by this paragraph is that comprising all those who, immediately before the principal appointed day, are employed as civil servants for the purposes of the *Civil Service Act 1990*.
- (3) The class prescribed by this paragraph is that comprising all those who, immediately before the principal appointed day, are employed by a Department or a Statutory Board on the terms contained in the Memorandum of Agreement between the Employers' Side and the Employees' Side of the Whitley Council for the Isle of Man Public Service (Manual Workers) as that Memorandum has effect immediately before the principal appointed day.

5 Consequential revocations

The following cease to have effect on the principal appointed day —

- (a) the Whitley Council for the Isle of Man Public Service (Manual Workers) Constitution 1989¹,
- (b) the Isle of Man Civil Service Joint Negotiating Committee Constitution 1991², and
- (c) the Civil Service Arbitration Agreement 1991³.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order prescribes the classes of public sector employees who become employees of the Public Services Commission on the 1 September 2015 (referred to in the Order as “**the principal appointed day**”).

Those who become employees of the Commission on the principal appointed day are those who immediately before the principal appointed day are —

- (a) civil servants within the meaning of the Civil Service Act 1990; or
- (b) persons employed by a Department or a Statutory Board on the terms contained in the Memorandum of Agreement between the Employers’ Side and the Employees’ Side of the Whitley Council for the Isle of Man Public Service (Manual Workers) as that Memorandum has effect immediately before the principal appointed day.

As a consequence of the making of the Order, certain agreements which related to negotiation mechanisms in the public sector cease to have effect, as set out in article 5.
