Fees and Duties Act 1989

WORK PERMIT (FEES) ORDER 2015

Approved by Tynwald: 23 July 2015
Coming into Operation: 1 October 2015

The Department of Economic Development, with the concurrence of the Treasury, makes the following Order under section 1 of the Fees and Duties Act 1989.¹

1 Title

This Order is the Work Permit (Fees) Order 2015.

2 Commencement

If approved by Tynwald, this Order comes into operation on 1 October 2015.

3 Interpretation

In this Order —

“**the Act**” means the Control of Employment Act 2014;

“**work permit**” means a permit granted under section 8 of the Act and, to avoid doubt, includes a work permit granted in accordance with section 9(1) of the Act.

4 Fees

- (1) Column 1 of the Schedule specifies particular services of the Department and column 2 specifies the corresponding fee, payable to the Department in respect of each service.
- (2) A fee specified in the Schedule is payable to the Department by the applicant at the time of application for the particular service except where arrangements between the Department and the applicant are in force for payment of fees on credit.

5 Revocation

The Work Permit (Fees) Order 2010² is revoked.

6 Transitional provision

This Order does not apply in relation to anything to be done or issued by the Department in respect of an application made before 1st October 2015.

FEES

Service	Amount of fee
For considering an application for a work permit where the permit is refused	£60
For issuing or renewing a work permit which is granted or renewed for up to 1 year	£60
For issuing or renewing a work permit which is granted or renewed for more than 1 year and up to 2 years	£120
For issuing or renewing a work permit which is granted or renewed for more than 2 years and up to 3 years	£180
For issuing or renewing a work permit which is granted or renewed for more than 3 years and up to 4 years	£240
For issuing a work permit which is granted or renewed for more than 4 years and up to 5 years	£300
For issuing a letter stating whether in the opinion of the Department, a person is an "Isle of Man worker" within the meaning of section 4 of the Act	£25

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order increases the fee to be paid on application for a work permit and also makes the amount of the fee dependent upon the duration of the permit granted.
