YEMEN SANCTIONS (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2015

Laid before Tynwald: 22 July 2015
Coming into operation in accordance with regulation 2

The Council of Ministers makes the following Regulations under section 2B and 2C of the European Communities (Isle of Man) Act 1973.

1 Title

These Regulations are the Yemen Sanctions (Amendment) Regulations 2015.

2 Commencement

These Regulations come into operation immediately after they are made.

3 Amendment of the Yemen Sanctions Regulations 2015

(1) The Yemen Sanctions Regulations 2015¹ are amended as follows.

(2) In regulation 3 for the definition of “the EU Regulation” substitute —

☞ “the EU Regulation” means Council Regulation (EU) No 1352/2014² of 18 December 2014 concerning restrictive measures in view of the situation in Yemen as amended by —

Council Regulation (EU) 2015/878³ of 8 June 2015 amending Regulation (EU) No 1352/2014 concerning restrictive measures in view of the situation in Yemen,

as these EU instruments have effect in the Island⁴, and a reference to a numbered Article or Annex (without more) is a reference to the Article or, or Annex to, the EU Regulation so numbered. ☞.

EXPLANATORY NOTE***(This note is not part of the Regulations)***

These Regulations amend the Yemen Sanctions Regulations 2015 (SD 2015/0035: “the principal Regulations”) to take account of the amendment of Council Regulation (EU) No 1352/2014 by Council Regulation (EU) 2015/878 as these EU instruments have effect in the Island by virtue of SD 2015/0035 and 2015/0244 respectively. The principal Regulations established offences and penalties for breaches of Council Regulation (EU) No 1352/2014, as it has effect in the Island, and they provided for the licencing by Treasury of activities which would otherwise be proscribed.
