## LAMBHILL ROAD, BRIDE (REGULATION OF PUBLIC SERVICE VEHICLES) ORDER 2019

*Made:* 18 February 2019  
*Coming into Operation:* 26 February 2019

The Department of Infrastructure after complying with the requirements of paragraph 1 of Schedule 2<sup>1</sup> to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 makes the following Order under section 1 of that Act.

### 1 Title

This Order is the Lambhill Road, Bride (Regulation of Public Service Vehicles) Order 2019.

### 2 Commencement

This Order comes into operation on 26 February 2019.

### 3 Interpretation

In this Order—

“**local bus**” means a motor vehicle constructed or adapted to carry more than eight but not more than sixteen passengers in addition to the driver; and

“**public service vehicle**” means a motor vehicle constructed or adapted for the carriage of passengers for hire or reward and which is constructed or adapted to carry more than eight passengers.

### 4 Restriction of public service vehicles

A person must not drive, or cause or permit to be driven, a public service vehicle other than a local bus upon Lambhill Road, Bride, between its junction with the A10 Bride Road and its junction with the A16 Cranstal Road.

5 **Revocation**

Paragraph 4 in Part II of the Schedule of the Regulation of Public Service Vehicles (Various Roads) Order 1976 is revoked.

*EXPLANATORY NOTE*

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

This Order prohibits public service vehicles from travelling on Lambhill Road, Bride, except for local buses.
