## **ROAD VEHICLES (INTERNATIONAL CIRCULATION) (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2019**

*Approved by Tynwald: 9 April 2019*  
*Coming into operation: in accordance with article 2.*

The Department of Infrastructure makes the following Order under section 1 of the Motor Vehicles (International Circulation) Act 1955.

### **1 Title**

This Order is the Road Vehicles (International Circulation) (Amendment) Order 2019.

### **2 Commencement**

If approved by Tynwald, this Order comes into operation on the day after that approval<sup>1</sup>.

### **3 Amendment of the Road Vehicles (International Circulation) Order 2006**

- (1) The Road Vehicles (International Circulation) Order 2006<sup>2</sup> is amended as follows.
- (2) In Schedule 1, in page 2 of the driving permit in form A, for “a period of 3 years”<sup>3</sup> substitute **“a period of one year”**<sup>4</sup>.

### **4 Consequential amendment of the Road Vehicles (International Circulation) (Fees) Order 2013**

- (1) The Road Vehicles (International Circulation) (Fees) Order 2013<sup>4</sup> is amended as follows.

(2) For article 3(1) (fees), substitute —

**64**(1) A person making an application for the issue of any document mentioned in article 4(1) or (2) of the Road Vehicles (International Circulation) Order 2006 must pay to the Department a fee of £11.**65**

## 5 Revocation

The Road Vehicles (International Circulation) (Amendment) Order 2014<sup>6</sup> is revoked.

*EXPLANATORY NOTE*

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

This Order reduces the period of validity of an international driving permit from 3 years to one year so as to be in accordance with the Convention on Road Traffic of 1949.

A consequential amendment is made to the Road Vehicles (International Circulation) (Fees) Order 2013 which reinstates the fee of £11 for such permits.

The Order also revokes the Road Vehicles (International Circulation) (Amendment) Order 2014.
