## **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION (PARKING PLACES) (MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS) ORDER 2019**

*Made<sup>1</sup>:* 28 March 2019  
*Coming into operation:* 1 April 2019

The Department of Infrastructure, after complying with the requirements of paragraph 1 of Schedule 2 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985<sup>2</sup>, makes the following Order under sections 11 and 14 of that Act.

### **1 Title**

This Order is the Road Traffic Regulation (Parking Places) (Miscellaneous Provisions) Order 2019.

### **2 Commencement**

This Order comes into operation on 1 April 2019.

### **3 Amendment of the Borough of Douglas (The Tongue) (Car Park) Order 2007**

- (1) The Borough of Douglas (The Tongue) (Car Park) Order 2007<sup>3</sup> is amended as follows.
- (2) In article 1 (citation, commencement and interpretation), omit the definition of “the Department”.
- (3) In article 9 (amount of excess charge at parking place) —
  - (a) in the heading, for “excess charge” substitute **additional parking charge**; and
  - (b) in paragraph (1) and (3), for “excess charge”, wherever occurring, substitute **additional parking charge**.
- (4) In schedule 1 —

- (a) for column 1 substitute —

<b>Parking Place</b>
<b>13</b> The Tongue Douglas (from its junction with Bridge Road to the fence delineating the harbour boat parking area at the eastern end of The Tongue, including both levels). <b>12</b>

- (b) for column 9, substitute —

<b>Scale of Charges</b>
<b>13</b> Up to 4 hours (8.30am - 6.00pm) £3.00; 24 hours (All day) £5.50; Overnight parking (6.00pm -8.30am) £2.00 <b>12</b>

#### 4 Amendment of the Parade Street, Douglas (Car Park) Order 2013


- (1) The Parade Street, Douglas (Car Park) Order 2013<sup>4</sup> is amended as follows.
- (2) In article 10 (amount of excess charge at parking place) —
  - (a) in the heading, for “excess charge” substitute **13**additional parking charge **12**; and
  - (b) in paragraph (1) and (3), for “excess charge”, wherever occurring substitute **13**additional parking charge **12**.
- (3) In article 20 (penalties and enforcement), for “excess charge”, wherever occurring, substitute **13**additional parking charge **12**.
- (4) In the Schedule, for rows 1 and 2 of Column 7 (scale of charges), substitute —

<b>13</b> Up to 4 hours £ 3.00 24 hours (All Day) £5.50 Overnight parking (6.00pm – 8.30am) £2.50

*EXPLANATORY NOTE*

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

This Order amends The Borough of Douglas (The Tongue) (Car Park) Order 2007 (SD 861/07) and the Parade Street, Douglas (Car Park) Order 2013 (SD 0092/2013) by increasing the parking charges for those car parks.

This Order replaces the term “excess charge”, wherever occurring in the respective orders, with “additional parking charge”.

The Order also revokes the following Orders –

- (a) Douglas (The Tongue) (Car Park) (Amendment) Order 2014 (SD 2014/0135);
- (b) Douglas Car Parks (Charges) Order 2014 (SD 2014/0385); and
- (c) Drumgold Street, Douglas (Car Park) Order 2013 (SD 0093/2013).
