ELECTRONIC TRANSACTIONS (GENERAL) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2019

*Approved by Tynwald: 18 June 2019
Coming into Operation in accordance with regulation 2*

The Department for Enterprise makes the following Regulations under section 8(1) of the Electronic Transactions Act 2000.

1 Title

These Regulations are the Electronic Transactions (General) (Amendment) Regulations 2019.

2 Commencement

If approved by Tynwald¹ these Regulations come into operation on 1 July 2019.

3 The Electronic Transactions (General) Regulations 2017 amended

- (1) The Electronic Transactions (General) Regulations 2017² are amended as follows.
- (2) In regulation 6 (temporary exemption for transactions with certain bodies), for paragraph (3) substitute –

☐(3) In this regulation “exempt body” means –

- (a) a public authority;
- (b) the General Registry;
- (c) the Central Registry;
- (d) the Registrar General;
- (e) the Clerk of Tynwald;
- (f) the Isle of Man Information Commissioner;
- (g) the Attorney General’s Chambers;
- (h) the Manx Museum and National Trust,

and includes any person acting on behalf of any of those bodies or officers. **22**

EXPLANATORY NOTE***(This note is not part of the Regulations)***

These Regulations amend the Electronic Transactions (General) Regulations 2017 in order to explicitly include the Central Registry and the Registrar General in the meaning of “exempt body”, consequent to the statutory establishment of the Central Registry by the Central Registry Act 2018.
